

AYSO Spring YDP Program

Region 2 will be participating in the Area 1C Spring YDP program for U10, U12, U14, U16 and possibly U19 divisions. This program is open to new and returning Fall Season players.

YDP play dates are from March 10, 2012 through May 13, 2012. Matches are scheduled on both Saturdays and Sundays on various fields. Local traveling may be required. Players attending Spring YDP program shall commit to the program and agree to give this program higher priority than other sports activities.

The cost for all players that played in Region 2 in the Fall 2011 Season is US\$50.00. For all other players the cost is US\$125.00. The costs will cover registration, uniforms and field usage. Make all checks payable to **AYSO Region 2**.

PLEASE NOTE: registered players ARE NOT guaranteed placement on a team, which is contingent on available coaches. Registered players, whose parent volunteers as a certified coach or assistant coach or active referee will be given priority. All volunteers must be MY2011 registered – check your volunteer status on eAYSO. Checks will not be cashed until players are placed on a team.

New players to Region 2 must register at the Arcadia Chamber of Commerce on Saturday, February 4, from 9:00AM to 1:00PM. New players must also provide proof of age: school record, immunization record, birth certificate or passport. New players will have a mandatory player assessment at registration, so please have your child wear cleats or proper shoes.

All players must register on **eAYSO.ORG** and submit one (1) signed copy of the player registration form.
